We welcome new and existing members for 2010. We trust the newly elected committee will work for success of our club in 2010.

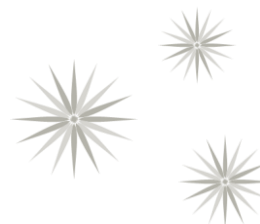
CVI Registration
